

The Region of Peel has not been able to provide the free, in-school vaccination clinics for Grade 7 and 8 classes since the pandemic began and as a result, most students from Grade 7 to 10 are currently not protected from Human Papillomavirus (HPV), Hepatitis B (Hep B), or Meningococcal ACYW-135.

The Region has created a number of clinic locations in the coming weeks to help families get these vaccines at no cost. Even if you do not live in the Region of Peel, Mentor College and TEAM School students are eligible for these clinics. If you live outside the Region, you may also be eligible for similar clinics in your area.

Please note that the clinics are not walk-ins; you must [book an appointment](#) for these vaccinations.

There are both regular clinics (typically open 5 or 6 days per week) and pop-up clinics (typically after school and located at a nearby high school) available. Please visit the [Region of Peel website](#) for a full listing of dates and locations.
